

While hazardous materials are not collected by the curbside garbage and recycling service, residents do have options to dispose of these types of waste. The Crud Cruiser mobile collection trailer travels to Eules twice a year to help residents responsibly dispose of their household chemical wastes. The City of Eules also provides recycling for electronics and small appliances onsite. Old paint, pesticides, used oil and other automotive fluids, household cleaners, solvents, batteries, and pesticides are all examples of household chemicals that could be hazardous to the environment if disposed of improperly.

Residents need to show proof of Eules residency and do not have to pay to drop off materials. However, the City of Eules is assessed a fee of \$47 for each household drop off. Please make sure you are maximizing your delivery.
